Iowa Breastfeeding Month Proclamation

In recognition of National Breastfeeding Month and World Breastfeeding Week in August, Governor Kim Reynolds signed a proclamation declaring August 2020 as Breastfeeding Month in Iowa. Due to the pandemic, there will be no normal signing ceremony, but the official document was sent to the Iowa Department of Public Health. Several communities across the state are making efforts to celebrate breastfeeding in virtual ways, such as hosting Big Latch On events and using social media for promotion and support.

2020 Legislative Session

During the 2020 legislative session, two bills related to breastfeeding support have been presented. Senate file 2317 calls for Medicaid reimbursement for breast pumps, including electric breast pumps and associated supplies, as prescribed by a Medicaid member's health care provider after a determination of necessity. Senate file 2319 requires the Iowa Department of Public Health "to convene stakeholders from various sectors to develop an actionable breastfeeding quality improvement strategic plan to determine the framework necessary to maximize breastfeeding support and improve the breastfeeding rate among all mothers in the state. The bill specifies that the strategic plan shall include goals and strategies by identifying potential system interventions and establishing a consistent approach relative to maternity care and hospital practices; workplace, peer, mother and family, and health care professional supports and education; and media and social marketing messaging. The strategic plan shall include steps to build collaborative partnerships and local coalitions to follow updated evidence-based best practices, policies, and procedures in supporting breastfeeding as the preferred long-term infant feeding method. The stakeholder group shall review the state's existing policies, practices and initiatives; analyze existing data and make recommendations for strengthening the state's data collection and evaluation capabilities; and analyze other state and national laws, strategic plans, initiatives, and programs to determine those which may be replicated or modified to meet the goals and strategies identified by the stakeholder group, including those specified in the bill." The strategic plan was to be submitted to the governor and the general assembly by December 15, 2020, but a proposed revision to the date was presented for no sooner than July 1,
